Summary and Objective:

This position is responsible for loading and unloading the line. Other areas of work may include, but are not limited to the following: primer booth, blast room, batch, and topcoat. It is beneficial to learn as much as possible in order to be more versatile in the entire coating process.

Essential Functions:

- Loading/unloading parts on/off the line
- Putting hooks away
- Masking parts or threaded holes
- Sanding re-coats or rusty material
- Banding and wrapping skids
- Maintaining a clean work environment in the loading and unloading area and all other areas as needed
- Other tasks assigned by your Team Leader or Supervisor

Characteristics and Competencies:

- Loading:
 - Inspect each individual part; watch for rust or damaged material, while using efficient hanging methods
- Unloading:
 - Inspect all parts for insufficient coating and/or defects
 - Use proper and necessary packing material
 - Band/wrap product securely to the skid to prevent damage in transit
- Assist in the following areas as training and experience allows:
 - Primer booth
 - Topcoat
 - Blast room
- Ask team leader for direction if/when current task is complete or on hold
- Stay engaged in your task throughout the entire work day
- Maintain a neat and organized blast room and work space, keeping floor and work space free from shot
- Attention to detail & quality focus
- Able to follow standard operating procedures
- Respectful, team-oriented work atmosphere
